Alford Campus is so much more than a school

In managing the £1.8bn Scotland's Schools for the Future programme, SFT works with every local authority across Scotland to help them achieve the very best value for their investment in new schools.

Of the 112 schools in the programme, 54 are under construction, 30 are in the final stages of development and 28 are open providing thousands of pupils across the country with first-class facilities.

Illustrating that desire to secure best value, many local authorities are now extending the use of their secondary school for local communities to use as well as incorporating nurseries and primary schools into the building so even more people can benefit.

Alford Community Campus in Aberdeenshire is one such building. It provides education facilities for children and pupils aged 3-18, it has a 25m four lane swimming pool, community library, indoor and outdoor sports facilities available for the community to use as well as being the base for Aberdeenshire Council's community learning and development team.
