

**SHCS 2002 NATIONAL REPORT
REVISED FIGURES
Chapter 8 – Access and Adaptations, pages 143-153 inclusive**

Date of Issue – 1 April 2004

On 9 March 2004 Communities Scotland issued a revision to the headline figures for Barrier Free housing due to a technical error affecting the original estimates. Users were advised to stop using the Barrier Free section of Chapter 8 of the report pending a further release of all the revised tables.

This document provides these revised figures. It is being published via the web ONLY. Hard copies will be sent with a covering letter to all who received the original publication.

Please note that the revision resulted in a decrease in the number of Barrier Free dwellings. This means that some of the detailed breakdowns originally published are no longer statistically valid. This document does not, therefore, contain revisions for every table in the original. The tables herein are numbered in the same way as the original, and so are not consecutive.
