eDEN Release 1.0.3

1. Catalogue Debt Type

A Debt Type of Catalogue has now been added to the dropdown list on the Create Debt page. Catalogue can now be found on the bottom of the debt type list.

2. Details transferring from CFT to eDEN

The Common Financial Tool can now be used to complete financial information and send all the details to a personal application in eDEN.

3. All Creditors showing post as preferred contact method in Debt card

All Creditors were showing their preferred contact method as post on the card view of the debts in an application form.

The list view of the debts on the application form now shows the creditors preferred contact method and the card view of the debts also shows the correct contact preference.

4. Income – Added Child Benefit option

On the Financial Statement in the personal application within the Benefits section there is now an entry for Child Benefit. This is shown on any new application started after the release. Any existing application forms will still need the child benefit added manually if appropriate.

5. Mandatory Debtor Contact Details

Within the Personal Application Debtors Details section, the fields Telephone, Mobile Number and e-mail Address showed as mandatory fields until one field had data entered into it. The fields could be left blank and mandatory warning was shown but the application could still be submitted. Submission now checks for one of the three fields to be completed before allowing the application to continue.
