## **eDEN Release 1.0.5**

### **1. Adding joint debt automatically selects the lead debtor**

When creating a joint debt, the lead debtors name was automatically prepopulating and it was not clear to the user that the box needed to be changed or updated.

This box now prepopulates blank and the user is prompted to either tick the debt is a joint debt or select a debtor from the dropdown before the debt can be added.

### **2. Change of frequency names**

The frequency names on the financial statement for all income and expenditure lines have now been changed to:

Weekly  
2 weekly  
4 weekly  
Monthly  
3 monthly  
Yearly

The word each has been removed from the front of the frequencies.

### **3. Applications with joint debts are not able to be submitted**

When a joint application was being created eDEN was looking to have at least one debt that was a joint debt before the application could be submitted.

This rule has now been removed and a joint debt is not needed on a joint application form.

### **4. Creditor able to create reviews on a rejected proposal**

If a Personal Application proposal is rejected a creditor can now create a review of the rejected decision through eDEN.

### **5. CMA Document Task List not populating**

Documents populating on a CMA case are now showing in the 'Letters to issue' task list. The proposal letters are not showing in this task list yet, this issue has been raised and users can access the documents through the documents section on the case in the meantime.
