I refer to your letter of 24 January and enclose the consent of the Secretary of State to the depositing of material on the Firth of Clyde shown upon the chart attached.

This consent is given solely for the purposes of Section 34 of the Coast Protection Act 1949, and you should satisfy yourselves that you have the necessary powers to do the work.

We understand that you are in communication with the Crown Estate Commissioners who have the management of the proprietary rights of the Crown in the tidal lands affected.

Conditions 3 and 4 of the Consent have been included at the request of the Ministry of Defence who have advised that the area adjoins a Submarine Exercise Area, and who have also asked that the Faslane Operations Room be informed before dumping runs are made.

Your attention is drawn to the need for compliance with the Collision Regulations (Ship and Seaplanes on the Water) and Signals of Distress (Ships) Order 1965 (SI 1525). A copy of the Order can be obtained from HM Stationery Office.

You may require a licence under the Dumping at Sea Act 1974 and you should contact the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries for Scotland if this has not already been done.

Would you please inform this Department when the depositing has been completed.

The Secretary of State hereby consents solely for the purposes of Section 34 of the Coast Protection Act, 1949 to the depositing by the Clyde Port Authority of 170,000 cu metres of material dredged from the area below high water mark of ordinary spring tides of Hunterston Ore Terminal as shown on the chart annexed.

This consent is given subject to the following conditions:

- 1 that no deviation from this area be made at any time without the further consent of the Secretary of State;
- 2 that depositing cease if at any time the Secretary of State so directs;
- 3 that depositing be restricted to the north-eastern quadrant of a circular area of 0.5 nautical miles radius, as shown on the chart; and
- 4 that deposits be evenly spread throughout the area.

This consent shall not, unless renewed, continue in force after the expiry of the period of three years from the date hereof.
