I refer to your letter of 21 January and enclose the approval of the Secretary of State to the Hunterston jetty works detailed in the approval and shown on the plans attached to it. I should make it clear that it should not be taken to relate to the area of Foreshore reclamation and the approach causeway for which we are awaiting plans as requested in my letters of 12 January.

The approval does not purport to give the applicants any right in the soil of the tidal lands to be interfered with.

No deviation from these plans should be made at any time without the further consent of the Department.

The Secretary of State hereby approves in pursuance of Section 11 of the Clyde Port Authority (Hunterston Ore Terminal) Order Confirmation Act 1973, to the construction by the Clyde Port Authority of an approach jetty, a jetty head and two pile mooring dolphins (Works Nos. 1, 2 and 4 described in Section 5(1)) below the level of mean high water springs at Hunterston, Ayrshire as shown on the plans annexed.

This approval is given subject to the following conditions;

1. that during construction the work be marked by means of two starboard hand lit navigation buoys located seawards of the works at co-ordinates 655200N, 219375E and 655750N, 219880E; and
2. that Officers of HM Coastguard or any other person authorised by the Secretary of State, be permitted to inspect the plans and works at any reasonable time.

This approval shall, unless renewed, continue in force after the expiry of the period of three years from the date hereof only in so far as the works have been completed at the expiry of that period.
